

Autum Checklist

The cold season is approaching in leaps and bounds. That's why now is exactly the right time to think about the coming expenses and dangers during the snowy and icy season. With our checklist you can make sure that everything has been thought of.

Water supply:

- ☐ Outside water tap turned off
- ☐ Supply lines insulated
- ☐ Rain barrels drained
- ☐ Cisterns covered in a cold-resistant way
- ☐ Livestock waterers and feed containers made frost-proof



- ☐ Gutters and downpipes cleared of leaves
- ☐ Measures taken against icing
- ☐ Snow pressure load tested for "light" roofs (e.g. garden arbour, carport, greenhouse)



- ☐ Slippery autumn leaves removed
- ☐ Rubberised step mats laid out
- ☐ Snow shovel and gritting material procured

Garden plants:

- ☐ Move potted plants to a frost-free place (e.g. summer / winter garden).
- ☐ Fixed, conditionally hardy plants (e.g. olive trees, hemp palms, almond trees) packed in thermo fleece
- ☐ Frost guard for sensitive plants in the greenhouse mounted



Tip:

With the self-regulating Mi-Heat frost protection heating cable 15W/m (art. no. 1235) you can effectively protect water pipes and containers from expensive frost damage.

Tip:

Our Mi-Heat gutter heating cable 30W/m (art. no. 1338) prevents frozen gutters and the formation of dangerous icicles. In addition, roofs can be protected from heavy snow loads.

The modular Mi-Heat rubber heating mats (art. no. 1053) are ideal for protecting icy stairs and entrances.

If a Mi-Heat frost protection heating cable 15W/m (Art. No. 1235) is wrapped around the plant pot, root ball or trunk, nothing stands in the way of safe wintering.
